## ITEMS ACCEPTED AT WASTE WATCH DROP OFF CENTERS – NO CHARGE

### HHW



Includes material such as:

- fuel (gasoline, kerosene, etc.)
- silicone, caulking, adhesives



- pesticides, herbicides, insecticides
- items with mercury



- aerosol cans (with contents)
- paints, solvents, stains, etc.



- cosmetics & personal care products



**HHW material must be sealed in original container. Jerry cans (or other containers) used for transporting the HHW must be left behind with contents**

### Batteries



Batteries can also be taken to most grocery stores including the Independent in Kensington.

### Cell Phones



Also accepted at most electronic retailers.

### Electronics

Electronic products include television, computers, speakers, printers, home theaters, etc.

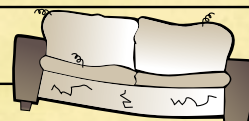
### Ink Cartridges



Also accepted by most electronic retailers.

### Large Bulky Household Furniture

Includes material larger than 4 feet or heavier than 50 lb. such as sofas, tables, china cabinets, mattresses, box springs, etc.



### Lead Acid Batteries

Also accepted at place of purchase and at scrap metal dealers.

### Tires

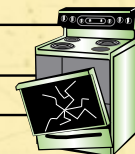


Must be removed from rims.

### White Goods



White goods includes appliances such as fridges, stoves, freezers, washers, dryers, hot water heating tanks.



### Propane Tanks



Tanks and cylinders 30 lbs or less can be taken to a WWDC, however any size tank can be taken to a propane dealer.

### Pet Medication

Pet medication **ONLY**. See below for human medication.

### Light Bulbs

**All lights bulbs:** Fluorescent (CFLs, linear, u-tubes, etc.), high intensity bulbs, LEDs, halogens, incandescent (any bulb that can be removed from the fixture)



### Motor Oil /Automotive Antifreeze

Oil fluids, containers, and oil filters; automotive antifreeze fluid and containers; automotive aerosol fluid and containers. May also be returned to any oil collection facility (see [www.soghu.com](http://www.soghu.com))

### Medications

### Sharps
